

WHO/EUROPE INTRODUCES EU-FUNDED "NURSING ACTION" PROJECT TO COMBAT NURSING SHORTAGES IN THE EU

WHO/Europe, in collaboration with the European Commission and the Polish EU Presidency, is set to launch the "Nursing Action" project on 17 January 2025 in Warsaw, Poland. This EU-funded initiative addresses the critical nursing

shortages across the EU by developing evidence-based strategies to boost nurse recruitment and retention. The launch event, part of a series of activities organized by the Polish Presidency, will feature discussions with health ministers, WHO representatives, and European nursing leaders. The "Nursing Action" project aims to enhance the attractiveness of the nursing profession, support current nurses, and implement safe staffing practices, all while integrating digital solutions into nursing workflows over a 36-month period.

A GOLDEN AGE FOR CANCER TREATMENT?




